Micro-chipping

Did you know that from 2011 all GAP dogs up for adoption come micro-chipped as well as desexed, wormed, vet checked and vaccinated? Yes, this is great news to keep all hounds safe.

If you are like me, you adopted your greyhound last year or earlier, you may have chosen to micro-chip off your own bat. GAPSA will be asking for these numbers eventually to add to our database.

Hot Weather Reminders

I am sure that you are all aware that hot weather means we have to think extra carefully about our Greyhounds and our schedules. Most of us will have to alter our walking schedules to later in the evening. Those of us who leave our Grey's outside during the day will have to carefully consider the areas they have to relax in and how appropriate those areas are when the temperature soars.

Here are some reminders:

- On a hot day, you should never walk your dog during the middle of the day or afternoon.
- Keep walks to the early morning (prior to 10AM) or evening (after 6PM). You may also have to consider shortening your walks.
- ALWAYS ensure that your dog has water available and don't stand them for long periods in the sun.
- Think about getting a claw proof kiddie pool / clamshell to fill with water for them to laze in.
- Restrict heavy exercise, especially if your dog isn't fit.
- Don't take your dog with you for lunch at a cafe' on a hot day and expect them to stand or lie on the hot footpath. If you can't (or wouldn't) then you can guarantee your hound doesn't want to either!
- The other thing that many people don't consider is the temperature of the ground they have the dog walking on. There's nothing more heart breaking than seeing a dog hopping from foot to foot

because their pads are burning on hot bitumen. Greyhounds are particularly prone to this as they have such soft, delicate pads. A good tip is to put your own hand on the bitumen or footpath before walking the dog on it. If it's too hot for your hand, then it's too hot for your dog to walk on. Keep this in mind if you take your dog to the beach, as sand gets particularly hot.

- The other killer for dogs is humidity. Dogs need air flow to help them keep cool. In humid weather, the air contains more moisture and it's harder for the dog to regulate their temperature by panting. Restrict exercise in humid weather and ensure the dog is in an area where it has a breeze or the air is kept moving (eg with fans)
- Angela has taught me to keep Juno cool by spraying her belly and paws, rather than the top of her coat. She loves it! Some dog coats when wet can act like a wet blanket, holding in the moisture and actually making them hotter. Spraying the belly and feet is the cool areas on a greyhound. ... hence the reason why they like clam shell pools and will step in their water bowl!
