ALLAN TOOGOOD – FOUNDER AND LIFE MEMBER NACA

Allan (Snowy) Toogood was born in 1925 in Morwell, Victoria. He had 5 sisters, Lorna, Beryl, Lillian, Jessie and Daisy. Allan worked in many jobs over the years with a majority lasting six months before he decided that it was time to try something else. He was employed as a banker, prison guard, fire officer, sideshow worker, hosiery assistant, boilermaker welder, fabricator, pet shop owner and pastry chef.

At 18, in 1943 he enlisted in the Royal Australian Navy and served as a cook until 1946. He served his time on ships from Darwin to Port Moresby and was involved in the attack on Darwin Harbour. He was awarded the 1939/45 Star Pacific Medal and Australian Service Medal.

On one of his travels to Perth he met Betty Jones from East Fremantle. Allan's dancing skills charmed Betty and they married in March 1951. Allan and Betty then moved to Fannie Bay in Darwin where they started the 'Toogood Tribe' of Rod, Larry, Mark, Andrew and adopted Debra. His love for animals especially dogs was immense. He founded the North Australian Canine Association in the late 1950s along with Noel Padgham. They both approached any owner of a 'pedigreed' dog they saw around Darwin, and asked them to show it. Four shows a year were held and if they got thirty dogs to a show it was a good show. The Show Society paid for judges and entry fees paid for the trophies. Noel's daughter Melissa remembers winning child handlers at one of these shows and receiving a Parker pen!

At these shows Allan had a large wooden crate (the size of a double door fridge) with arc mesh sliding doors. As he and Noel were busy during the shows stewarding and writing the judge books all Allan's dogs were accommodated in this crate, sometimes along with his young children!

Snowy by now was showing Labradors and Dachshunds. Noel met Allan when she first came to Darwin in 1959 with a dachshund bitch in season and was looking for a stud. Allan had the only male dachshund in Darwin. Noel's bitch had a wonderful keel and shoulders but a very sway back, Allan's dog had a straight back you could put a level on, but a terrible front. They thought together they would get stunning puppies with this wonderful straight back, perfect keel and perfect shoulders. How wrong they were! It was a steep learning curve for both of them after that.

Snowy was also instrumental in starting up the first obedience club with Mrs Cross as an instructor. These classes were held at his place in Bayview Street, Fannie Bay and five or six dogs participated paying one shilling each (10cents).

Allan was also very obliging in raising money for the NACA. This included his boys selling raffle tickets to the neighbourhood, until they went to a policeman's house. Seems it wasn't quite legal and that was the end of ticket selling! Fund raising was also selling beef sartays at the annual Mardi Gras held in Knuckey Street. As Snowy was in the meat business and if anyone wanted steaks for parties or bbq, Snowy was the man to know.

Dog meetings were held in the Town Hall foyer (where the Darwin Entertainment Centre is now). Noel was appointed the first life membership and Snowy was awarded his life membership shortly after that. Meetings were later held in one of the four government houses (Animal Industry Branch) approximately opposite where the current Greek Orthodox Church is now. Snowy was President and Steve Lorman was the first Secretary/Registrar, a job which Noel took over later on. Shows were held at the showgrounds and Allan, helped by Noel's husband Phil, built a number of benches for the dogs..

Allan moved to Perth in 1965 and lived in Swanview, later moving to Helena Valley where he built dog kennels, breeding cats and dogs. Allan worked as boiler maker/welder at Bradshaws and later at the Midland Abattoirs. Allan bred chocolate red cloud kelpies in WA which he brought over from Victoria and showed them at shows including Perth Royal.

Allan was also the President of the RSPCA. He helped to weld and build the Darwin Rodeo facility as well as being Cubmaster for many boys in Darwin. Allan was the first Darlington Scout Master and was a great mentor for many scouts and touched many people's hearts.

Betty and Allan moved to Greenmount after most of the tribe had left home. Happy times with Betty were had there until Betty's sudden passing in 1982 after 30 years of marriage.

Allan met another lovely lady Win and they married in 1984 and built a home in Stratton. He still loved to travel and he and Win travelled around Australia and overseas until Win became ill and both moved into The Pines Nursing Home in Ellenbrook. Sadly Win passed away after 20 years of marriage. Allan wanted to be independent so he rented a unit in Midland after a period of travelling moved into Morrison Lodge Nursing Home. He still got out on his gopher when he wanted to. He only had two controls on his gopher, stop and flat out. His favourite sayings were 'poor bugger me' and 'it's hard to be humble' and 'my kids are perfect, just ask them'. His final move was to Belmont Nursing Home with its friendly staff but he sadly missed his gopher and freedom.

Allan was very laid back about things, very kind and compassionate and adored his dogs. He was always happy, always smiling and always willing to help.

The meeting was very productive and a lot of decisions made there will have a positive effect on the Australian dog world well into the future. Unfortunately, due to delays in the approval process we cannot publish the meeting summary in this edition, however as soon as it becomes available a link will be posted on the DOGS NT Facebook page.

For some time I have been saying we are attempting to get all the forms on the website interactive, that is where the basic form is protected from unauthorised changes but where you can fill the form in on your computer. The program that would allow everything to be done is around \$1000.00, despite applying for 3 different government grants we have been unable to secure funding to purchase this software, so a compromise has had to be made.

The updated forms are currently being uploaded on to the DOGS NT web site, these will allow you to complete all of the details in Microsoft Word and save the form to your computer. The only part that cannot be filled in will be the signatures, so you will still have to print the form out in order to sign it before sending it to the office.
