 - d. Provide a financial report to each meeting of Council.
 - e. Act as a counter-signatory on cheques (including any electronic transactions).
 - f. Assist with the preparation of annual financial statements.

Have custody of all securities, books and documents of a financial nature and account records of the NACA j. Ensure the President of the NACA, or another Councillor as directed by Council is advised of all passwords and protocols required to access the financial records of the NACA. RATIONALE: The first 3 clauses in this section of the current constitution relate to the duties of the Administrator. These duties cannot and should not be performed by a volunteer when it is more practical and expedient for them to be done by an employee. APPROVAL OF JUDGES FOR ALL NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL EVENTS

On the occasion of its meeting in Rome on 13-14 April 2011, the FCI General Committee adopted the following resolution:

All the judges invited to officiate at any **national** or **international** event organised by an FCI national canine organisation (FCI NO) or by a club affiliated to an FCI NO **MUST** first and foremost get the approval of their FCI NO.

We draw your attention to the fact that the specific clauses included in the *FCI Show Regulations* (Art 10, **INVITING JUDGES**, h) and i)) remain valid.

This measure is effective IMMEDIATELY for all invitations as from the date of publication of this circular.

President's Report

The Territory Tour has come to an end for another year and going by the amount of titles applications that have come through the office (from both the conformation and performance disciplines) it has been very successful for some of our members. Special congratulations to Peter and Nikki Jones and of course Meazle on gaining the final points for his Grand Champion title (Grd Ch Sunspur Zuess CD ET).

One of the best things about this time of year is the opportunity to meet exhibitors from interstate and their dogs, especially those rare breeds that we do not normally get to see up here. This year we were graced with two breeds I have never interacted with before. The first was the Skye Terrier, this boy was wonderful in dealing with strangers like me wanting to get up close and personal. Keeping all that coat in show condition while on the road for the complete Tour would be too much work for a lot of us and is a credit to his owners.

And then of course there was the Xoloitzcuintle's, the rarest of rare breeds in Australia with only the 2 being shown in the whole country. I am not a judge, but my first impression was, "What a dog!" I think they made a big impression on exhibitors and the general public as well. The males name being NACA (although pronounced Narca) just endeared him to me just that little bit more.

There were many other visitors as well, some on their first tour and others who we consider honorary locals. Thank you for being part of our showcase events and if you have any suggestions or ideas that we can use to make future Territory Tours better, please don't hesitate to let me know. From the messages and photos on facebook, it appears that Camp Wallaby Holtze was the place to be for visitors to Darwin. With dog friendly accommodation becoming scarcer, Melissa and Steve have done a wonderful job in showing what Territory hospitality is all about.

In other news, I travelled to Alice Springs before the start of the show season to meet with the clubs and discuss numerous issues. The one issue that everyone had was the lack of opportunity for members outside of Darwin to be represented and participate in Council. While the tyranny of distance has always been a problem, we are now well into the technology age and there are now ways to overcome this. Council will be working on this issue and I am hopeful that we can have everything in place in the not too distant future to make it a reality.

My visit to Alice Springs was made possible by a grant from the NT Governments Community Benefits Fund.

Withdrawal of Border Collie Litter Registration Limitations (LRL)

We refer to the Border Collie Litter Registration Limitation (LRL) resulting from the 2009 Breed Survey.

At the request of the National Border Collie Council the LRL's as surveyed in 2009 will be withdrawn until they have been reconsidered by the National Border Collie Breed Council.



Until that has occurred and the ANKC has received further advice from the National Border Collie Breed Council there are no limitations on registration of Border Collie litters.

Clause 8.7 has been removed from ANKC Regulations Part 6 at this time and the ANKC website will be updated accordingly.
