

ANKC Ltd Regulations Part 5 – Amendments to existing Titles and addition of New Title:

It was resolved at the recent ANKC Conference to amend/
add the following sections/clauses in Regulations Part 5:

- Amend Section 1, Clause 1.1;
- Amend Section 3;
- Amend Section 5, Clause 1 (a), (b), (c), (f);
- Amend Clause 7.7;
- Amend Clause 7.9;
- New Clause 7.10.

Championship Points System – refers Clause 7.7 – *amended (10/11)*

The owner of a dog registered with the ANKC Ltd which:

- (a) Wins not fewer than four Challenge Certificates/Best of Breed Certificates under not fewer than four different Judges at four different exhibitions; and
- (b) Gains a total of 100 points; may apply for such dog to be known as a Champion

Grand Champion Title – refers Clause 7.9 – *amended (10/11)*

It was resolved that from 1 January 2012 the requirements for the Grand Champion Title will revert back to the Pre 1 January 2010 requirement of 1,000 points only, and the requirements of: 1 All Breeds Best in Show: or 4 Best in Group: or 4 Certificates of 25 points will be removed.

All dogs that qualify for the Grand Champion title under Regulations Part 5 Clause 7.9 are eligible to apply for the title after the implementation date of 1 January 2012.

Supreme Champion Title – NEW – refers Clause 7.10 – *addition of New Title (10/11)*

It was resolved to introduce a new conformation title 'Supreme Champion'. The requirements to attain this new title by using the points system as approved by ANKC Ltd at the time will be 1,000 points, including 3 All Breeds Best in Shows; or 10 Best in Group/Specialty Best in Shows. Either 3 different Best in Show Judges or 10 different Best in Group/Specialty judges must be submitted, there can be no repeated judges.

The implementation date of the new Supreme Champion title will be 1 July 2012.

A Supreme Championship will not be awarded to animals retrospectively, but an animal will be eligible to be awarded the title of Supreme Champion, if they gain some points towards the title of Supreme Champion (1000 points) after the implementation date of the 1 July 2012.
